As of 31 December 2020, Healthy Seed's services have reached over **400 institutions** and its training courses have benefited **over 37,000 recipients**, including children, parents, social workers, educators and professionals.

1. Hands-On Parent Empowerment-20[®] Program (HOPE-20[®] Program) & Various ECCD Training Programs

HOPE-20[®] Program

HOPE-20[®] Program is one of the first locally-developed and evidence-based parent education programs in Hong Kong. It is based on the research conducted by :

Joining hands with Hong Kong Christian Service, Healthy Seed implements the HOPE-20[®] Program and various parenting programs to support ECCD. Education Officers (Registered Social Workers) of Healthy Seed have conducted HOPE-20[®] Parents' Group and HOPE-20[®] Train the Trainer to:

- Enhance parent-child relationships
- Facilitate children's learning and language development
- Encourage positive behaviors
- Handle problem behaviors

1.1 HOPE-20[®] Parents' Group

This parent education program comprised 20 two-hour group sessions is designed for parents with children aged 2-3. Its aim is to enhance parents' knowledge and skills to advance family well-being.

3. Media Programs for Public Education

ViuTV & TVB myTV SUPER

“Super Daddy” Series 《超級奶爸》系列

“Super Daddy” series focuses on parenting methodologies designed for toddlers aged 2-6, featuring how the theories derived from HOPE-20® could be put into practical use. A total of 24 episodes (8 episodes x 3 seasons), highlighting parenting problems of 20 families, were produced and broadcast on ViuTV in 2017 and 2018; and on TVB myTV SUPER and TVB Anywhere in 2019.

As of 31 December 2020, “Super Daddy” series has recorded over 8,600,000 views. As well presenting the series on different platforms, coverage has extended to Macau, Mainland China, Singapore, Australia, Canada, USA and various cities in Europe.



RTHK Radio 31

“Adorable Baby” Series 《寶寶你好嗎》系列

“Adorable Baby” series was broadcast on RTHK Radio 31 between April 2015 and April 2017. The program focused on families with children aged 0-6 and highlighted problems with nursing and disciplining their children. Experts such as psychologists and speech therapists were invited to share their professional advice in 52 episodes (13 episodes x 4 seasons).

Morning Suite 《晨光第一線：親子百分百》

Since September 2017, Education Officers (Registered Social Workers) of Healthy Seed have been sharing parenting skills twice a month on the radio program Morning Suite on RTHK Radio 2. As of 31 December 2020, a total of 80 episodes have been aired. Topics include effective parenting skills and child moral development.

Facebook Live Chat 《親子互動直播室》

An interactive multi-media program, Facebook Live Chat 《親子互動直播室》, was launched in March 2019. Education Officers (Registered Social Workers) of Healthy Seed and professionals were invited to share knowledge and advice on positive parenting and healthcare issues. This real-time live program allowed professionals to answer questions raised by parents and Facebook fans immediately.

4. Music Cradle 🎵

Healthy Seed has supported the “Music Cradle” program, organized by the Music Children Foundation (MCF), to offer free early music education to children aged 1-6 living in Sham Shui Po since October 2014. The program hinges on the belief that music is an agent of social development to transform children’s lives by developing their cognitive abilities and strengthening their sense of belonging to our community through ensemble-based musical literacy.



5. Water for Free & Say No to Plastic 💧

In 2018, Great Eagle Holdings Limited sponsored Go Green Hong Kong to work with Healthy Seed in its “Water for Free” Campaign to install water dispensers across Hong Kong. The campaign offered free, clean and safe drinking water to schools and the public. In addition, education talks were organized. In 2019, the campaign was scaled up in the name of “Say No to Plastic!” with an aim to extend the reach of the plastic-free message.
